WANDSWORTH COUNCIL

All residents will have received the notice from Wandsworth Council regarding support for the vulnerable and volunteers which was distributed by email on Saturday morning. Any resident who does not receive email will have received a hard copy through their letterbox - distributed with all due hygiene precautions.

You may be interested to know that the office has also received a phone call from Councillor Jane Cooper, the Mayor of Wandsworth, enquiring after the wellbeing of the estate and all residents.

GENERAL

We do appreciate that compliance with the government's restrictions are burdensome and that the experience of staying indoors at home unless absolutely necessary can take its toll on mental well-being, especially for those living alone.

Following the Prime Minister's address last night, we must, however, tactfully remind you of the need to isolate yourself from others in accordance with government strictures at all times. It is also particularly important to take great care when touching commonly used surfaces such as door handles and locks and we urge you to wipe these down (with such appropriate materials as you have available) both before and after use.

To that end we have now been able to source hand sanitiser dispensers which will be placed in the entrance ways of each stairwell to assist with hygiene. Once these are in place, we would still be grateful if residents continue to take responsibility for cleaning any public surface area that they touch. We expect the hand sanitiser to be in place later this week. Please can everyone ensure that they remain in place for use by all residents on the stairwell.

We are extremely grateful to those members of our community who have gone out of their way to help fellow residents and support, both spiritually and practically, our extremely hard- pressed and dedicated staff.

We hope that you and your families remain safe and well.
