LATE NIGHT DELIVERIES

There are many residents who enjoy the convenience of deliveries to their door – and this has been especially so during the last year. However we have been advised that there continue to be late night/very early morning deliveries to the estate which are causing a disturbance to fellow residents. Whilst we appreciate that it is not always possible to request exact delivery times, please can all residents take responsibility for specifying that their personal deliveries are not made after 10pm or before 8am (as stipulated on the website). HEALTH AND SAFETY AUDIT

As some residents may be aware, a health and safety audit was conducted on the estate in November by Tetra Consulting who are contracted to Manor Fields to oversee health and safety risk management and compliance. The inspector was on site for a period of 5 working days. He undertook a detailed examination of all the required on site record keeping, inspected the grounds and all the individual buildings on the estate, and met with key members of the staff and board members. The Board are awaiting the final report and recommendations.

SKY Q INSTALLATION

Please be aware that if you wish to install SKY Q you need to contact the Estate's cabling and systems contractor, Power on Television. Their contact number is 0800 193 7688. Anyone wishing to upgrade will need their assistance as the current cabling system in each house is not set up to automatically accommodate Sky Q and the SKY engineers do not have access to the main cabling set up in each stairwell.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

Doubtless residents will be aware of the repair work to the paving stones which is currently taking place around the entire estate. Once the work is complete it is assessed that 470 slabs will have either been restabilised, relaid or replaced and all the pathways will have been checked.

We would ask that you are particularly careful when parking your cars as repeated poor parking is a main contributor to damage caused to the kerbs and the paving stones.

STAFF

The last few months have seen some staff changes at Manor Fields and we would like to introduce you to a few new faces around the estate.

Donna Wilson: Donna was employed in September on a six month part time contract to undertake all the on site checks and input of data to Prism, a new health and safety compliance software package which Manor Fields are now using for all our health and safety record keeping on the estate. Donna has 20 years prior experience as the Health and Safety officer at a private school.

Ella Buckley: Ella has recently joined the team of gardeners. She has completed her Level 4 Certificate of Higher Education in Practical Horticulture and Plantsmanship at Cambridge Institute and apprenticeship at the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew.
